Dear Friends,

This Sunday we say farewell to **Station 14**, our contemporary music group. I want to thank all of its members, past and present, for their commitment to helping lead us in worship. For many of them, it meant traveling some distance every Sunday, and often during the week to practice (most members don't live in Newark!). Although we will revert as a parish to a more traditional use of organ on Sundays at 12:00 noon Mass, our prayers go with them as they continue their music ministry in different ways. I am excited to know that they will be part of a new diocesan initiative called "**XLT**." This is a monthly praise and adoration evening for teens rooted in the *Life Teen* model that will take place once a month in a number of locations in the diocese. For example, in November we will be hosting "**XLT East**." We will be encouraging our teens to attend these monthly events in addition to the Jesus Jams that take place at St. Agatha's, Upper Arlington, once a month.

On June 28th at 10:30 a.m. in church, there will be a celebration of Holy Mass in Latin using the Extra-Ordinary Form (popularly known as the Tridentine Mass). Fr. Kevin Lutz will offer the Mass and give an introduction before Holy Mass begins. After Holy Mass, he will lead a question and answer session. The whole "event" will take about two hours. Pope Benedict XVI has encouraged us to enter more deeply into the liturgical heritage of the Church, and to recognize that this way of celebrating Mass is still valid and relevant for us today. I encourage you to attend Holy Mass on this occasion and experience the awesome mystery of God's love as it was celebrated in the Church's life for hundreds of years.

**Parish Pilgrimage to Carey Ohio**

The Father Bill Johnson Council of the Knights of Columbus is sponsoring a Parish Pilgrimage to Our Lady of Consolation Shrine in Carey, Ohio, on Sunday, August 10, 2008. Our plans are to charter a 55-passenger bus for this pilgrimage. If the bus is filled, the cost per seat will be \$12.50. If we do not sell out the bus, the cost per seat will need to be increased to cover costs. There is an **optional** cost of \$8.50 per person for lunch in the Shrine cafeteria. We plan to leave from the **Park and Ride** (Route 16 freeway at the Dugway) at 7:30 a.m. We will be attending the noon Mass with Fr. Adam Streitenberger and Father David Orians concelebrating. After Mass will be time for lunch and then the prayer service with the blessing of the true relic of our Lord's Crucifix. Immediately following, we will process to the park and pray the Stations of the Cross. We plan to be back in Newark by 7:00 p.m. This will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
